TO: All Distributors, Dealers, Owners and Operators

SUBJECT: Engine Oil Thermostat Kit

MODELS AFFECTED: PA-23, Serials 23-2 to 23-15 inclusive, 23-17 to 23-76 inclusive, 23-78 to 23-81 inclusive, 23-83 to 23-162 inclusive

There is now available for the Apache airplane an engine oil thermostat kit. This kit will maintain average oil temperature of approximately 180°, except in extreme cold weather operation. Kit 754 096 can be ordered through your nearest Piper distributor on a no charge basis. It is estimated that it will take less than two hours to install this kit; however, no warranty labor will be allowed.

When the thermostat kit has been installed, the temporary oil cooler covers which have been installed on some airplanes in the oil cooler air intake scoop on the bottom cowl are unnecessary and must be removed.
