Modification of the oxygen cylinder rear retaining strap part number 758 109 to preclude the possibility of the strap rubbing the rudder control cable.

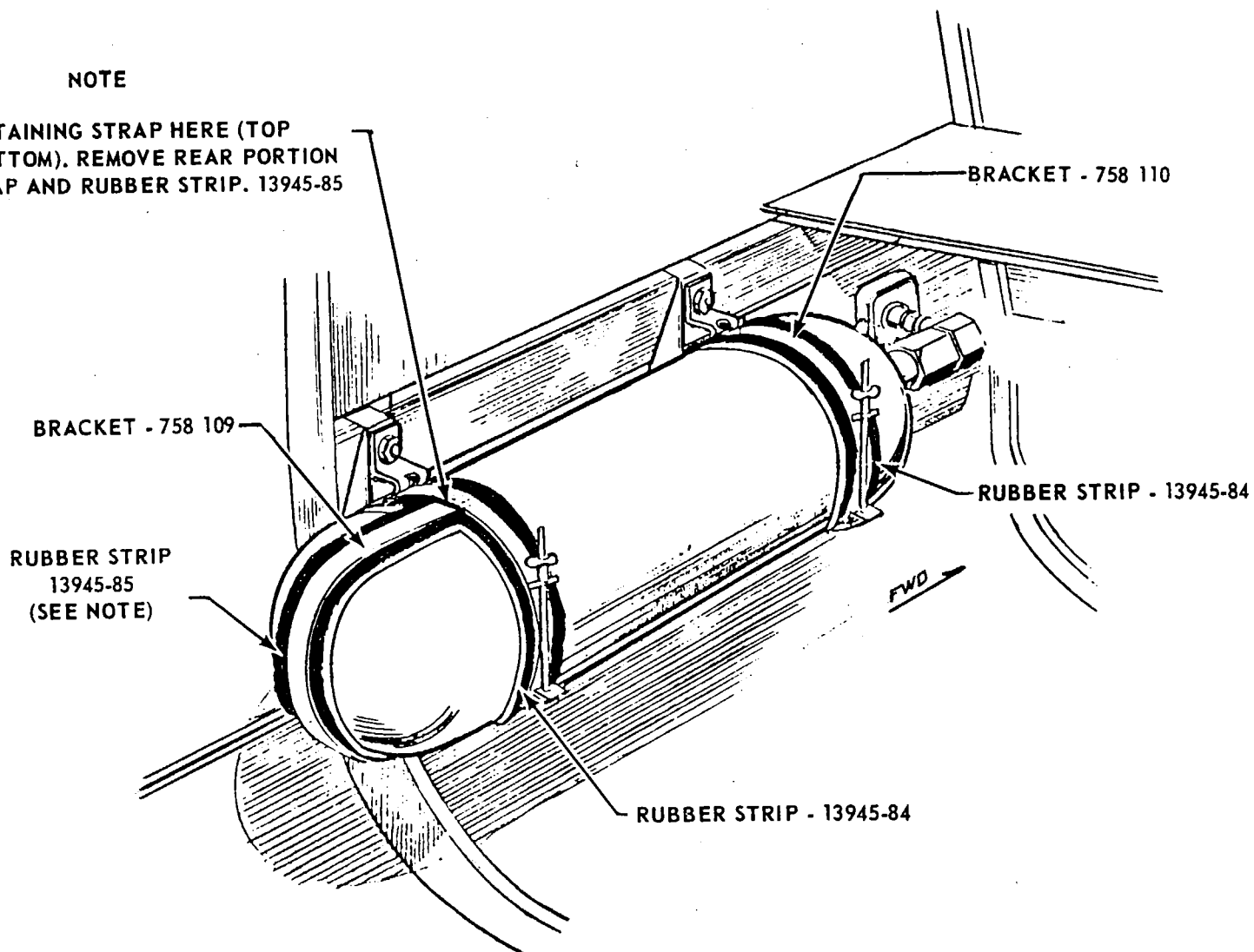
